

Leading Around You

A free course on the foundations of collective leadership, based in Southern & Western Newfoundland.

Grounded in Mi'kmaw principles and Msit No'kmaq ("all my relations"), this course brings together virtual learning, guest speakers from across Newfoundland and Labrador, and four days of land-based learning on the South Coast.

You'll explore real challenges facing your community and the surrounding area, as well as develop your own ideas for how to make a difference. You will get a university credit, certificate of completion, and tablet to continue your learning journey.



What will you do?

- **Explore** your identity, culture, and connection to place
- **Learn** from Elders, community leaders, and researchers
- **Experience** five days of learning on the land and water
- **Tackle** real problems facing your community
- **Build** skills in leadership, collaboration, and problem-solving
- **Create** and share a project that matters to you

Who can join?

All are welcome. However, participants under 29 will get priority including high school students (Grades 11–12) and young adults (ages 18–29). Course enrolment is limited. Enrol today!

- **Date range:** Aug. 14 to Oct. 31
- **Land-based:** Aug. 14 to 16
- **Virtual sessions:** Once a week Sept. and Oct. (days and time to be confirmed with participants)
